<u>INSPECTIONS</u> Apartments are inspected for cleanliness, repairs that may be needed, and any possible improvements. If you have any questions or problems, they can be discussed during the inspection. We need access to ALL your windows and rooms. Please make sure ALL items are removed from the window area. Please remove all items off the top and inside of your stove and on the burners as well. Call in any work orders before the inspection. Poor housekeeping, missing fire detectors, and any damage beyond ordinary wear and tear are grounds for a failed inspection.

PHOTO PROOF OF IDENTITY

We are in the process of adding pictures to your resident files. This ensures that the people we encounter in the apartment are supposed to be there and when maintenance or Lease Enforcement comes by, they can put a name with a face. Nobody else besides NETX staff will see your account profile pictures. Please submit (non-filtered) individual pictures for all members of the household so we can upload them to your profile. Please provide name of household member with every picture. You can email these to andy.craytor@netxproperties.org. If you do not have an email you may come by the office so we can snap a picture.

Please note: NETX Properties will not call you back to confirm your work order, and we do not call ahead to let you know we're coming. The fact that you are requesting maintenance services means you are giving permission to enter your apartment. If we do the work when you are not home, we will leave a notice letting you know.

Roasted Greek Salmon and Broccoli

Ingredients

- 1 bunch broccoli, cut into large florets
- 2 tablespoons olive oil
- 3/4 teaspoons kosher salt
- 1/2 teaspoon black pepper
- 1/2 teaspoon garlic powder
- 4 (6-ounce) salmon filets
- 1 tablespoon Dijon mustard
- 2 tablespoons honey
- 2 teaspoons balsamic vinegar
- 2 teaspoons Greek seasoning
- 1 lemon, cut into wedges
- 1/4 cup crumbled feta cheese

Directions

- Preheat the oven to 450 degrees F (230 degrees C). Line a baking sheet with parchment paper.
- Add broccoli to the prepared baking sheet, drizzle with olive oil, and sprinkle with salt, pepper, and garlic powder. Toss to coat and spread in an even layer on the baking sheet. Create 4 spaces within the broccoli for salmon filets and place each filet in an empty space.
- Combine Dijon, honey, and balsamic vinegar in a small bowl and stir well.
 Spread mustard mixture over each salmon piece and sprinkle each piece evenly with Greek seasoning.
- Bake in the preheated oven until fish flakes easily with a fork, about 12 minutes, or until desired doneness.
 Remove from the oven; squeeze lemon juice over the sheet pan and top
