Trash Procedure for New Boston

Please dispose of all trash in the trash bins provided for you. Keep your yard and common areas cleaned and clear of litter. As a tenant, it is crucial to understand your responsibilities regarding trash removal. NB Trash is picked up every Monday, Wednesday and Friday, starting at 7:30AM.

Trash Requirements

- Place garbage bins out for collection no later than 7AM on the assigned collection day.
- Ensure the lid is completely closed and the bin isn't overflowing. No trash bags on the ground.
- All trash must be in 13-gallon trash bags and inside the provided bin.
- Residents are responsible for cleaning out their individual garbage bins.
- Once trash has been collected, roll the bin back to its designated spot.

Please follow the requirements or charges could apply.
