Of course, there are so many autumn-inspired sweets to bake this season too, and we're just dreaming of all the apple cobblers, pumpkin cheesecakes, and sweet potato pies to be made. Try these amazing soft, perfectly pumpkin-y, irresistibly spiced plus, the chocolate chips add that decadence you love in a cozy fall cookie.

# Pumpkin Chocolate Chip Cookies

### Ingredients

- 1 cup canned pumpkin
- 1 cup white sugar
- 1/2 cup vegetable oil
- 1 egg
- 2 cups all-purpose flour
- 2 teaspoons baking powder
- 2 teaspoons ground cinnamon
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1 teaspoon baking soda
- 1 tablespoon vanilla extract
- 2 cups semisweet chocolate chips
- 1/2 cup chopped walnuts (optional)

### Directions

- 1. Combine pumpkin, sugar, vegetable oil, and egg. In a separate bowl, stir together flour, baking powder, ground cinnamon, and salt. Dissolve the baking soda with the milk and stir in with the flour mixture. Add flour mixture to pumpkin mixture and mix well.
- 2. Add vanilla, chocolates chips, and walnuts
- Drop a spoonful on greased cookie sheet and bake at 350 degrees F for approximately 10 minutes or until lightly brown and firm. Enjoy!
